- June is Indigenous History Month. This is an opportunity to reduce the stigma, discrimination and racist ideas of Indigenous identities in Canada and Nova Scotia. As Eagles and citizens of this country, we can focus on education, promoting cultural awareness and building respectful relationships. We encourage everyone to seek opportunities to learn and connect with Indigenous individuals and communities.
- Throughout the month we will highlight an Indigenous leader and learn a new word. Today we highlight: Louis Riel. He was a Métis leader who fought to protect the rights, culture, and land of the Métis people in the 1800s. He led the Red River Resistance, which resulted in the creation of Manitoba in 1870. Although he was executed for his role in the North-West Resistance of 1885, he is now recognized as a founder of Manitoba and an important defender of Indigenous and minority rights. Word of the Day; Wela'lin (Mi'kmaw); Meaning: Thank you; Phonetic: *weh-LAH-lin*; Fun Fact: This is one of the most commonly learned Mi'kmaw words in Nova Scotia.
